All Star Camp 10 – 14 year olds

For children with limited to no speech with current knowledge of visual communication.

Concentration on structured play and socialization.

One-3-week session

June 4 – June 21 Monday – Thursday 9am – 1pm

\$450 per 3-week session

Limit: 4 children minimum 6 children per session

Explorer Camp 7 – 14 year olds

For children with high functioning ASD and Aspergers and their siblings and friends.

Concentration on leisure skills, social communication, friendships and fun.

Two 3-week sessions

Session I – *Around the World in Twelve Days*, June 4 – June 21, Monday - Thursday 9am-1pm

Session II – *Inventors Workshop*, June 25 – July 12 (no camp Wed. July 4th) Monday – Thursday 9am-1pm

For ASD teens with beginning Social Thinking® skills

Concentration on leisure skills, social communication, friendships and fun.

Two 3-week sessions

Session II - June 25 – July 12 (no camp Wed. July 4th) Monday – Thursday 9am – 1pm
